

Late Night Trips FAQ

Who Can Ride?

Late Night Trips (LNT) is for Fair Family only. Any person who receives a 2019 camping pass from the Oregon Country Fair is eligible to purchase a Late Night Trips bus pass.

Cost?

For our 50th Anniversary Celebration, an LNT bus pass will cost \$20.00 for the entire Fair including Thursday. Anyone less than 18 years of age will be free under the condition below. There will be no refunds if you do not pick up or use your pass.

How Do I Register?

The Registration Form follows this FAQ page and you can download it or send your email address to ocflatetrips@gmail.com and you will receive a Registration Form by email. Fill out the form including which trips you are most likely to ride; read the fine print; and send in your check or cashier's check to: Late Night Trips, OCF, 442 Lawrence Street, Eugene OR 97401. Multiple people can be on one form. Anyone less than 18 years of age must be registered and accompanied on any LNT bus by one of the adults who signed his/her Registration Form.

I've Sent In My Registration Form And My Money On Time, Where Do I Pick Up My Pass?

You will pick up your pass at the Troubleshooting Window on the far right hand side of the Wristband Booths. Look for the Late Night trips sign. You must show your camping pass or an ID to receive your bus pass laminate. You will also receive a vehicle sticker for parking at Valley River Center. You may get your bus pass during anytime Troubleshooting is open Wednesday, July 10th - 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM; Thursday, July 11th - 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM, Friday, July 12th - 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM; Saturday, July 13th - 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM; and Sunday, July 14th - 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

What's The Deadline?

Registrations Forms and payments must be in by July 1st. You will receive a confirmation email that you have successfully registered, a map showing you where to park at Valley River Center and other info. Your confirmation email means you are in the "Book" at Troubleshooting.

We are serious about the deadline. If your registration and money are received after July 1st and you do not get a confirmation email, you will not be in the "Book," no matter how many times you tell Troubleshooting that you sent in your form and money. You can buy a pass from Troubleshooting and your late payment will be refunded after the Fair.

What Is The Bus Like?

The LNT bus is a retired city style bus that seats about 40 people in comfortable bucket type seats. Many of the seats face each other and there is a wide aisle. We have water on the bus so please bring your refillable water bottles. (We will also have cups.) The bus has party lights and a good sound system on which we play a special playlist each night to get you in a traveling mood. No drinking or smoking on the bus, but dancing can happen in the wide aisle. The bus has a power ramp for wheelchairs.

Where Do I Catch The Late Night Trips Bus On Thursday To Go Out To The Fair?

On Thursday there will be 2 trips out to the Fair leaving from Valley River Center at 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM. The bus will also stop at the downtown Eugene Public Library on the 10th Avenue side at 10:15 AM and 3:15 PM. On these trips, the LNT bus coming from town will stop at the wristband booth so people can get their camping and bus passes.

How Do I Get Out To The Fair On Friday, Saturday And Sunday?

You can take a Worker's Bus from Valley River Center which leaves between 6:45 and 9:30 AM or an LTD bus which leaves Valley River Center and the downtown LTD Terminal from about 9:30 AM to around 5:30 PM

Where Do I Park My Car At Valley River Center Or Downtown?

Your registration confirmation email will include a map, which is highlighted to show where to park at Valley River Center. It is the northwest parking lot that the Workers buses and free LTD buses use. When you pick up your bus pass, you will also receive a vehicle sticker to alert Valley River Security that you are a Late Night Tripper. Parking downtown is more difficult and please makes sure if you do park that it is good for the hours you will be at the Fair. Some people ride an LTD bus to the downtown terminal and catch one of the free LTD buses out to the Fair.

Where Do I Catch The Bus At The Fair To Go Back To Eugene?

On all nights, Late Night Trips uses one of the two OCF Bus Stop tents, which are the two large tents just outside Main Camp. The LNT sign will be on the west tent, The tent will have lantern light, benches to sit on and a Late Night Trips team member there to greet you.

What If I Forget The Schedule Or Miss A Departure Time?

The schedule is printed on the back of your Late Night Trips bus pass laminate, designed again by Stephanie Talbott. All buses leave on time. If you miss the early bus, you are welcome to ride the later bus, but you might have to stand if others have already picked that trip on their registration forms.

If I'm Not Going To Use My Pass, Can I Give It To Someone Else?

YES, if you want to share your pass with someone else that's great. Just remember that anyone less than 18 years old has to be accompanied by an adult who signed his/her Registration Form.

Can I Buy A Pass At The Fair?

YES, you can buy a pass for \$20.00 at Troubleshooting at anytime it is open during the Fair. You will need to show an ID or Camping Pass, read the fine print and sign the Registration Form.

How Do I Get My Free 50th Anniversary Poster?

The first 100 registered riders will receive a VIP laminate and are entitled to a free 50th Anniversary poster. The posters will be on board the Late Night Trips bus. We thought that getting them as you depart in Eugene would be the easiest, but you can get one from the bus anytime you ride or it is parked at the OCF Bus Stop.

6. The Fine Print

- 1. All Late Night Trippers (passengers) must have a 2019 “Camping Pass” wristband or photo ID “Camping Pass” issued by the Oregon Country Fair in addition to a Late Night Trips Bus Pass in order to ride on any of the scheduled Late Night Trips.
- 2. Each person who purchases a Late Night Trips Bus Pass will be guaranteed a seat for the Trips chosen above in the Schedule Selection.
- 3. * No one under 18 years old will be allowed to ride a Late Night Trips bus without being accompanied by one of the adult signatories on his/her Registration Form.
- 4. All Registration Forms and payments (Checks or money orders) for LNT Bus Passes must be postmarked or received before July 1, 2019 at the address below.
- 5. No smoking or drinking alcohol on the bus. Water will be provided for Late Night Trippers. Please bring your reusable water bottle.
- 6. Alexander Limousine & Oregon Party Bus of Veneta, Oregon (USDOT#2017044) will operate the buses and provide the above scheduled service between the OCF Bus Stop area, Valley River Center and the Eugene Downtown Public Library on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday of the 2019 Oregon Country Fair.
- 7. It is each Late Night Tripper’s (passenger’s) personal responsibility to be at all designated Bus Stop areas in time to board the Late Night Trips selected above in this document. Buses will leave as scheduled. Neither the Oregon Country Fair nor Alexander Limousine & Oregon Party Bus are responsible for providing a ride to or from Eugene for Late Night Trippers who miss the scheduled departure times.
- 8. Neither the Oregon Country Fair nor Alexander Limousine & Oregon Party Bus are responsible for any items left on any Late Night Trips buses.
- 9. All Late Night Trips Bus Passes and Car Stickers will be picked up at the Troubleshooting Window at the Wristband Booth.
- 10. Late Night Trips Bus Passes will be sold on a first come, first served basis and there will be no refunds.
- 11. By signing below, I/We understand and agree to the Fine Print above. I/We have enclosed our payment. I/we are responsible for distributing the passes to everyone listed on this Form. Anyone over 18 listed on this Form must show photo ID when picking up his/her Bus Pass(es).**
