Voting in favor of offering a booth/cart space for the 2018 fair:

Results:

Psychedelic Thai : Unanimous Vote (6 in favor) no abstains.

Approved for 4 types of scoops, one drink Thai Chili Basil Tea, stuffed dates. No Mango sticky rice. No sandwich or wraps, no coconut. Candidate for a cart for the 2018 fair.

Prices seemed high on the dates.

The Cannery: 4 in favor, 2 no votes.

Approved for a booth space. Not approved for sweet potato sandwich. Invite booth rep to a meeting/food tasting on March 28th to taste a new vegetarian option. The booth rep may choose to simply not serve the sweet potato sandwich.

The MAC: 4 in favor, 1 abstain, 1 no.

Approved for a booth space. Call the booth rep and let them know that they are not approved for the Gluten Free option but that they can bring a new gluten free option tasted on March 28th.

Bite Me Foods: Voting on donuts on March 28th.

Tea Ticklers: 4 in favor, 0 no votes, 2 abstain

Approved for a cart.
