- Committee meetings

- One off community partner training events
- Weddings/Memorial Services
- Classes

- Kids Camp/Parties/Day camp/Summer Camp
- Benefits/Fundraisers (some already happen onsite)
- Yoga or other exercise sessions during OCF
- Educational opportunity if built as flagship green building
- Fair archive
- Late night music scene during the event
- Community dance
