



## WANDERING PERFORMER GUIDELINES OREGON COUNTRY FAIR

Wandering Performer Guidelines have been created to assist path performers at the Oregon Country Fair in having and creating positive experiences. In the OCF spirit of free and creative artistic expression, anyone is welcome to perform on the paths as long as they do so within these guidelines. As performance space is at a premium, it is important that each performer be flexible, considerate, and cooperative. Please be conscious of your space, sound levels and those around you including other performers, stages, attendees and booths.

### **Important Safety Notice Regarding Fair 2022 and COVID 19:**

**First and foremost, let's do our best to keep ourselves and each other as safe and healthy as possible. Please do not perform if you have any symptoms of COVID 19. If you feel sick, please stay home. If you get sick, go home as soon as possible and isolate from others onsite until you are able to leave.**

**Performers are asked to socially distance and stand at least 6 feet away from fair attendees and audiences when possible. Consider incorporating masking into your costuming. Please do not initiate any physical contact or come physically close to fair attendees without an explicit invitation and consent.**

### **GENERAL WANDERING PERFORMER GUIDELINES**

**Fair Hours: 11:00am-7:00pm**

- Do not set up or start a show that competes for the audience of other path and stage performers.
- Rotate performance spaces by wandering throughout the Fair.
- Help your audience keep paths open for foot traffic.
- Connect with booth members before setting up in front of a booth.
- Cooperate with all Fair and Entertainment staff.
- Solicit donations with discretion and respect. Only officially booked performers may sell merchandise.
- Battery powered amplifiers and recorded music are prohibited.
- Performers not following these guidelines will be asked to stop and may, in extreme circumstances, be escorted from the Fair.
