Meeting Discussion included:

- Issues with the Zoom link not working (.net site versus email link?)
- Previously worked to separate secretary duties into Membership and Recording roles; currently the Board does not have two secretaries
 - Arna spoke to keeping the bylaws as is so that we are not restricted by being more specific
 - Lisa said by law we are required to have one secretary (along with a president and a treasurer); added verbiage to state designee
- We continued our final review of each section of the bylaws, and creating the draft for the proposed amendments: spreadsheet section 114 through 132
 - Grammar and punctuation to ensure language is clear and consistent (i.e., Annual Membership Meeting, the Board versus Directors, and removed gender specification)
 - Oregon law indicates minutes for membership meetings by a designated officer; Heidi said the annual election report by the Membership Secretary could be considered minutes
 - Review of Stephen's recommendation Our Articles of Incorporation were amended in the early 90's, to make the roll of members private and a method for members to communicate with other members; Oregon law states members are not required to give an address
 - Scheduled an extra meeting in December so we can finish spreadsheet and get draft ready for attorney review
