Path Planning met September 10th 2023:

A site walk started in Xavanadu at the new KOCF Alcove, which received mostly positive feedback this year. Additional benches and reorienting existing benches for better view of the stage is recommended, as flowers blocked the view.

The new Moon Path Childcare area was heavily attended and well received, there was feedback about the need for more mellow space and stroller parking that Path Planning is considering.

New bleacher seating at Chez Ray helped spectators better engage with performers.

The new stage at Spirit Tower received good feedback, but the railing needs attention for safety. The new fence needs the bottom cut off to allow floodwaters.

The new fence in the Junction Smoking section also needs the bottom cut off to accommodate floodwaters. There was a suggestion to extend or add to the fence to achieve the goal of better separation from the path and nearby water fountain.

Possible clandestine tree plantings have been found in the area near Altared space. These trees were originally thought to be invasive Tree of Heaven, but ID apps say they may be Bitter Cherry. Path Planning is investigating how to remediate.

A majority of the willows planted for the River Willow Restoration Project do not appear to have survived. Dogwoods in the shade seem to be thriving. Path Planning will continue the conversation at our next meeting to consider how best to proceed.

Native/Indigenous artists would like a collaborative vendor area near Arch Park. Path Planning will coordinate with Archeology and the Artists to identify an agreeable location.
