

3/17/2024 Path Planning Board Report

Path Planning met on Sunday March 17th 2024 with a Site Walk looking at the willow and dogwood plantings and accompanied by Whitney from Art Ambiance to speak about up and coming art projects and to share ideas about path enhancement.

Recommendation to Alexis to work with the nursery team to remove the non-viable tree/shrub starts from the bank and, if possible/recommended/warranted move successful starts to fill in the area. It was noted that more success was seen in shaded areas and in starts that were inserted with the use of a hodad as opposed to being shoved through the soil.

Support for subtle lighting in willow planting bank areas along Shady Grove. Possible twinkling lights in Shady Grove tree.

Acknowledgement of vandalism of Art Ambiance's Alice in Wonderland checkerboard, clouds and tea party in Way Back Way park on Abbey Road last year. BUMs and Mngmt are involved.

Kevin Hillery shared the EAB report and it was discussed that education and outreach should take place about encouraging attendees and crews coming from or through Washington County to drive through a carwash on their way onto the OCF property. (.net and .org websites, social media, booth registration packets, coordinators, craft and food committee meetings)

Recommendation to begin making signs bilingual, beginning with bathroom signage, including "close the lid" signs.

Naming brainstorm for Politics Park stalls and creation and placement of You are Here signs.

Preliminary discussion and map study of one year only booth creations on Sun Path in Xavanadu.

Preliminary map work and discussion about Native Crafter area in Xavanadu. Invite impacted parties to April meeting.
