Who Can Ride?

Late Night Trips (LNT) are available exclusively to the Fair Family. Anyone who receives a 2026 camping pass from the Oregon Country Fair can buy a Late Night Trips bus pass.

Cost?

An adult LNT bus pass cost \$25.00 for the full Fair, including Thursday; ages 11-17 pay \$15.00, and children 10 or under ride free. Passes are non-refundable.

How Do I Register? Go to www.oregoncountryfair.net to download a FAQ sheet and the Registration Form. You can also send your email address to ocflatetrips@gmail.com and you will receive a Registration Form and FAQ sheet by email. Fill out the form including which trips you are most likely to ride; read the fine print; sign it; and send in your check or cashier's check to: **Late Night Trips, OCF, 442 Lawrence Street, Eugene OR 97401**. Multiple people can be on one form. Anyone younger than 18 years of age must be registered and accompanied on any LNT bus by one of the adults who signed his/her/their Registration Form.

I've Sent in My Registration Form and My Money on Time, Where do I Pick Up My Pass?

You will pick up your pass at the Troubleshooting Window on the far-right hand side of the Wristband Booths. Look for the Late Night Trips sign. You must show your camping pass to receive your bus pass laminate. You can get your bus pass at Troubleshooting on

- Wednesday, July 8th - 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM
- Thursday, July 9th - 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM
- Friday, July 10th - 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM
- Saturday, July 11th - 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM
- Sunday, July 12th - 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

What's The Deadline?

Registration forms and payments must be postmarked or delivered to the OCF office no later than June 25, 2026. Once your registration is successful, you'll receive a confirmation email with parking details for Valley River Center and other important information. This confirmation means you are officially listed in the "Book" at Troubleshooting.

Please note that the deadline is strict. If your payment and forms arrive after the cutoff date and you do not receive a confirmation email, you will not be listed in the "Book," regardless of how many times you contact Troubleshooting about your submission. In this case, you can purchase a pass directly from Troubleshooting, and your late payment will be refunded after the Fair.

What Is the Bus Like?

The LNT bus is a retired city style bus that seats about 40 people in comfortable bucket type seats. Many of the seats face each other and there is a wide aisle. The bus has party lights and a good sound system. No drinking or smoking on the bus, but dancing can happen in the wide aisle. The bus has a power ramp for wheelchairs.

Where do I Catch the Late Night Trips Bus on Thursday to the Fair?

On Thursday, there are two departures for the Fair from the Valley River Center parking area at 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Each bus will also pick up passengers at the downtown Eugene Public Library on 10th Avenue at 10:15 AM and 3:15 PM. During these trips, the LNT bus coming from town will stop at the wristband booth so riders can collect their camping and bus passes.

To ride to the Fair, you must be registered with LNT and listed in the Book. We cannot accommodate those who have not registered or intend to purchase a bus pass at the Fair.

How do I get to the Fair on Friday, Saturday and Sunday?

You can take one of the Worker's Buses from Valley River Center which leave regularly between 6:45 and 9:30 AM or an LTD bus which leaves from either Valley River Center ~~and~~ or the downtown LTD Terminal from about 9:30 AM to around 5:30 PM

Where do I Park My Car at Valley River Center or Downtown?

Your confirmation email will include a map highlighting parking at Valley River Center in the northwest lot, used by Workers buses and free LTD buses.

Parking downtown can be challenging. If you park on a city street or in a lot, check that it covers your Fair hours. Alternatively, take an LTD bus to the downtown terminal and transfer to a free LTD bus to the Fair.

Where do I Catch the Bus at The Fair To Go Back To Eugene?

Each night, Late Night Trips operates from one of the two large LTD Bus Stop tents outside Main Camp. The LNT sign will be on the west tent, which has lanterns, benches, and a team member to greet you.

What if I Forget the Schedule or Miss a Departure?

The schedule is on the back of your Late Night Trips bus pass. **All buses depart promptly.** If you miss your bus, you may take a later one, but seats are first-come, first-served based on registrations.

If I'm not Going to Use My Pass, Can I Give It to Someone Else?

YES, if you want to share your pass with someone else that's great. Just remember that anyone less than 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult who signed his/her/their Registration Form.

Can I Buy a Pass at The Fair?

YES, passes are available for purchase at Troubleshooting whenever it is open during the Fair. Please be ready to present your Camping Pass, review the Fine Print, list any riders under 18, and sign the Registration Form.
